


## **WHO ARE WE?**

This free, hybrid **24-hour** event will be taking place from **May 14th** to **May 15th** at Vincent Massey Secondary School in Windsor, Canada. MasseyHacks will be filled with thrilling opportunities for students to learn and create in the realms of computer science and technology. Students will have the option between participating in-person or virtually.

This year, MasseyHacks VIII will be preceded by MasseyHacks: JumpStart, a 5-week collection of events intended to expose students to a diverse set of workshops, challenges, and activities in topics ranging from web development to hardware and more! With the help of hands-on workshops and experienced mentors, JumpStart will help students build a strong foundation upon various STEM-related topics and pave the way for developing their skillset.
